

Building an Online Ed.D. Program on a Foundation of Research-Based Best Practices

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This session chronicles the initiative of a Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) program to improve the quality of its online courses. The initiative included three objectives in the application of research-based best practices for online course design: (1) train faculty, (2) provide internal resources and guidance, and (3) achieve external certification of Ed.D. program courses. As a result of the successful completion of these objectives, the program outcomes included: improved online student experiences; faculty, course, and program recognition; and a competitive advantage in the marketplace. Recommendations include the use of Quality Matters for research-based best practices and course review certification as well as a comprehensive team effort focused on student outcomes.

Initiative Objective #1

Train faculty and staff on the utilization of internationally recognized <u>research-based best</u> <u>practices</u> and processes for quality in the design of online courses

All faculty members with Ed.D. program core and research courses required to successfully complete the <u>Applying the Quality Matters Rubric (APPQMR) workshop</u> and recommended to successfully complete the <u>Improving Your Online Course (IYOC)</u> workshop

Initiative Objective #2

Provide internal resources and guidance to faculty in the implementation of internationally recognized research-based best practices for quality in the design of online courses

"How Can a Course be Prepared for an Official Review"

Internal Course Reviews: Instructor taught the course a minimum of two semesters and instructor successfully complete the Applying the Quality Matter Rubric (APPQMR) Workshop

External Course Reviews: <u>Subscriber-Managed by a certified Course Review Manager (CRM)</u>

Initiative Objective #3

Achieve external course review certification for all courses in the Doctor of Education program

<u>All fourteen core and research courses</u> in the online Doctor of Education program have received Quality Matters certification
