

Course Review Challenges










Strategies and Practices We Are Trying

☐ A culture of collaboration

- > Building relationships, all roles
- Guidelines







Strategies and Practices We Are Trying

- ☐ Less than three meetings
 - > Internal team meeting
 - > Meet with academic program
 - > Implementation





Strategies and Practices We Are Trying

- Ongoing and sustainable
 - > <3 meetings per review
 - > 3 priorities (immediate, partial, future)
 - > 3 times/year with the program
- Applicable to all programs
