Online/Blended Course Design Components of an Effective Lesson

I. Big Question and Lesson Goals (Daily Objective)

- State and post objective(s) before introducing the lesson.
- Students will record the Big Question in their Project Journal.

II. Review and Connect (Daily Review)

- Provide a review for short-term memory over recently taught material
- Provides a foundation to connect to the new skills being covered in the lesson
- Includes vocabulary

III. Why Is This Lesson Important (Introduction)

Sets the stage for real world learning

IV. **Concept Development** (Concept and Skill Development)

- Teach the big concepts
- Provide the 'why' for rules and algorithms
- Link concepts to previously taught material or real-world experiences
- Utilize a variety of techniques: students need to say it, hear it, say it, and do it
- Students will record notes in their project journals

V. **Guided and Independent Practice** (Guided/Independent/Group Practice)

- Enhances conceptual understanding or application of concepts
- Provides time for inquiry, investigation, discovery, lab or problem-solving activities
- Students need time to think, analyze, work on problems, and reflect on processes

VI. **Assessment** (Homework Assignments)

 Include a variety of assessment items: definitions, computations, applications, etc.

VII. Reinforcement (Closure)

• Have students explain what they have learned and apply it
