#### Test Centers around the State

Some distance education courses require students to take proctored exams. A proctor supervises a student's exam that is taken offcampus location.

It is up to each student to find a qualified proctor. Typically, a student schedules the exam with a proctor, and the exam is sent to the proctor to administer. The proctor then returns the completed exam to the instructor to grade. Generally, proctors do not charge for this service.

#### In all cases the instructor offering the course must approve of the choice of proctor.

Acceptable proctors for most courses include:

- · high school principals or counselors;
- · directors of educational services at universities, correctional institutions, or the armed services;
- · certified librarians in a supervisory positions;
- · delegated officials of a university testing center.
